#### From Augusta:

- Route 201 north towards Winslow.
- From intersection of routes 3 and 201 in Augusta drive about 7 miles and turn right onto the Bog Road in Vassalboro.
- About ½ mile past Vassalboro Community School turn right at the four way intersection onto Cross Hill Road.
- Quaker Lane is ½ mile - first road on the left.

#### From Waterville:

- Take Route 201 south towards Augusta.
- At second four-way intersection past Oak Grove School (State Police Academy) turn left onto Bog Road.
- About ½ mile past Vassalboro Community School turn right at the four way intersection onto Cross Hill Road.
- Quaker Lane is the first road on the left.

#### From points east:

- Take route 3 to China.
- Turn right onto route 32 north towards East Vassalboro and Winslow. Follow Route 32 into East Vassalboro Village.
- Turn left at the four way intersection by the Country Store.
- The turn for Quaker Lane is on a fairly sharp corner on your left about one-mile from the village.
